Notes for New Members

Welcome to The Norfolk Club. We hope you will enjoy using the club. The following notes address some of the questions frequently asked by new members.

1. Ordinary members may elect to extend their membership to include their spouse as a Joint Member on payment of an additional annual subscription of £175.00. Joint Members have all the responsibilities and privileges of full membership of the Club including voting at General Meetings and sitting on committee.
2. The Club is affiliated to several other clubs in London, throughout the country and overseas. The list of these clubs is updated from time to time and is available on the club website. A membership card and letter of introduction, available from the Club Secretary, are required when visiting an affiliated club.
3. Spouses and Children maybe bought into the Club as guests. No child under 12 years of age may come into the Club unless accompanied by a responsible adult. No person under the age of 18 years shall be elected a Member of the Club.
4. Any member may bring into the club a guest or guests. No person residing in Norfolk may visit the Club as a guest on more than 4 days in any year.
5. Places in the rear car park can be rented on an annual basis, please see the Club Secretary for further information. Spaces not occupied after 10am maybe used by any member on payment of a fee of £4.00 per day.
6. Spaces at the front of the Club must be reserved by contacting the steward on 01603 626767. The cost of parking at the front is £2.00 for up to 2 hours, £4.00 for half a day and £8.00 per day. Members cars must display a Club parking sticker. These are available from the Club Secretary.
7. The Club has six bedrooms. These are available to members and maybe used by friends or business associates of members by arrangement with the Duty Steward or Club Secretary.
