Notes for new members

Welcome to the Norfolk Club. We hope you will enjoy using the Club. The following notes address some of the questions frequently asked by new members.

1. Ordinary members may elect to extend their membership to include their spouse as a Joint member on payment of an additional annual subscription of £125.00. Joint members have all the responsibilities and privileges of full membership of the Club including voting at General Meetings and sitting on committees.
2. The Club is affiliated to a number of other clubs in London, throughout the country and overseas. The list of these clubs is updated from time to time. A membership card, available from the Manager is required when visiting an affiliated club.
3. Children may be brought into the Club, when accompanied.
4. Places in the rear car park can be rented on an annual basis - the Secretary has further details. Spaces not occupied after 10am may be used by any member on payment of a fee of £4.00 per day by way of tokens available from the bar.
5. Spaces at the front of the Club must be reserved by contacting the Steward on 01603 626767. The cost of parking at the front is £2.00 per half day and £4.00 per day. Members' cars must display a Club parking sticker. These are available from the duty Steward.
6. The Club has six comfortable and modestly priced bedrooms. These are available to members and may be used by friends or business associates of members by arrangement with the Secretary or Head Steward. Bookings should be made with the Steward on 01603 626767.
7. The Club is happy to arrange private parties and other functions for members. Meeting rooms are also available for hire and refreshments can be arranged.
8. In the Dining room, the central table is the "Club" table. All members are free join it but the convention is that as each member arrives he takes a seat next to those already seated at the table. Tables reservations can be made with the Steward on 01603 626767.
9. Members are invited to settle Dining room bills directly after with the Steward in the bar.
10. There is a no smoking policy throughout the Club.
11. There is strictly no tipping of Club staff. Arrangements are made for members to express their appreciation through the Christmas Staff Fund.
